

Last will of Mary Elizabeth Wollberg

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; that I, Mary Elizabeth Wollberg, of Terre Haute, Vigo County, State of Indiana, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills by me made.

After payment of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and burial and the expenses connected with the administration of my estate, I give, devise and bequeath all the real and personal property of which I may die seized, as follows, to-wit:

Item No. 1. To my executor, as such, whomever it may be, I give and bequeath the sum of (\$10) ten dollars in trust to be used for the following to-wit:-

A. To erect a marker over my grave and not to pay over (\$10) ten dollars for the same.

B. I direct my executor to see that my body is laid to rest in the Amanda Peck Family Burial lot at Highland Lawn Cemetery at Terre Haute, Indiana, and to place the above mentioned marker or stone thereon.

Item No. 2. All the rest and residue, of my estate I devise and bequeath to my husband, William Wollberg if he be living at the time of my death and if he be dead, it is my desire that it be considered as part of

residuary estate and be distributed as may be provided in the will of said William Wollberg for the distribution of his residuary estate.

Item No. 3. All the real property of every kind and description of which I may die seised, I give and bequeath to my Husband William Wollberg.

Item No. 4. I hereby name and appoint my Husband William Wollberg to be the executor of my will; in event of his death I name and appoint Benjamin Blumberg to be such executor.
